The Striking Lofts Yungay II: Colouring the Streets of Chile!

Creating a harmonious flow of colours across the streets of the World Heritage Area of Valparaíso, Chile, the flamboyant Lofts Yungay II was carried out by Antonio Menéndez and Cristian Barrientos founders of the Rearquitectura architecture firm. Located on a steep hillside in an urban zone, this building complex was designed to house twenty individual units and each painted in a different colour. The lofts include six two storey units with a small garden overlooking the cliff side view, three one storey that are at the street level and eleven three storey lofts each with a fabulous rooftop terrace overlooking the ocean.

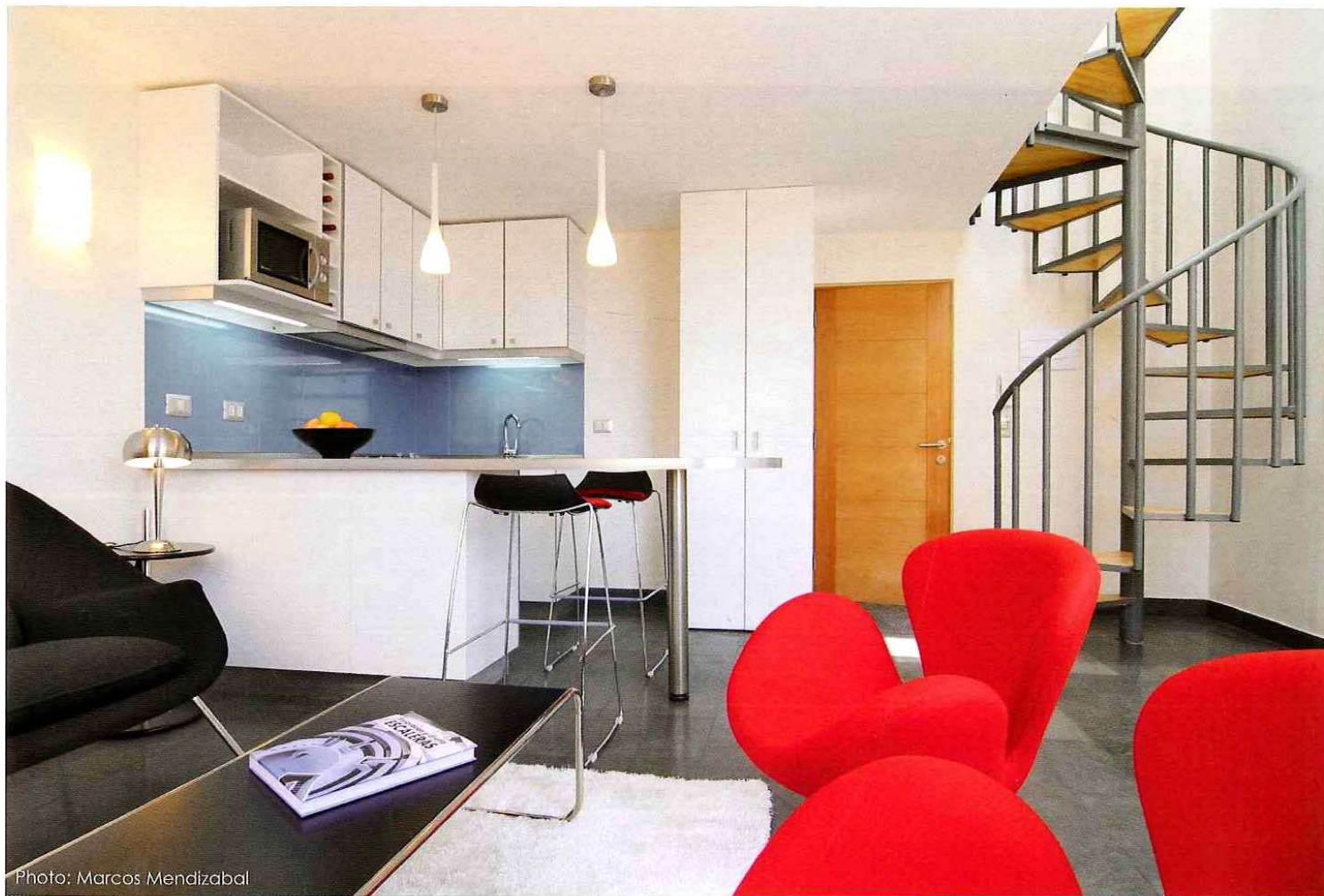
